# TTF Mission, Scope and Goal

## Mission:

*“Realize transport of captured CO<sub>2</sub> within the second investment cycle”*

## 2015 Scope:

- 1) Identify and prioritize the topics in close relation to transport of captured CO<sub>2</sub> in the Baltic Sea region and*
- 2) Identify international research needs*

## 2015 Goal:

*Prepare and submit an application for funding of transport research*

# „HOW THE FOCUS SECTORS CAN CONTRIBUTE TO THE TRANSPORT DEPLOYMENT?“

Alternative 1; three steps:

1) X–border network building and partner matching and communication

2) Market survey = What does the industry need for deploying CCS in collaboration with other Task Forces

*Steps 1&2 to be done separately or in combination, through e.g several cross border workshops etc.*

3) Study in combination with other Task Forces e.g communication, based on the results from step 1&2
